Rules

- A. Selection will be made on the basis of neatness of appearance, simplicity of pattern and usefulness of decoration.
- B. No sugar starch will be permitted.
- C. More than one piece in a set, fasten together and mount for display.
- D. Specify kit or original.
- E. Limit 5 entries per class.
- F. Either an Excellent, Very Good or Participation ribbon will be awarded to each participant. First, second, and third place, and Honorable Mention ribbons will be awarded in each class.
