

HANDIWORK DIVISION

Rules

- A. Selection will be made on the basis of neatness of appearance, simplicity of pattern and usefulness of decoration.
- B. No sugar starch will be permitted.
- C. More than one piece in a set, fasten together and mount for display.
- D. Specify kit or original.
- E. Limit 5 entries per class.
- F. An excellent, very good, good or honorable mention ribbon will be awarded to each entry. First, second, and third place ribbons will be awarded in each class. There is one Best of Show for each subdivision.

Subdivision A

1. Clothing
2. Fabric Work (such as braided rug, stuffed toy, pillow)
3. Woven Item

Subdivision B

4. Quilts – Combination Hand & Machine Stitched
5. Quilts – Handsewn
6. Quilts - Machine Stitched

Subdivision C

7. Knitted Work
8. Crocheted Work
9. Tatting

Subdivision D

10. Counted Cross Stitch
11. Embroidery - Miscellaneous (such as Bargello, Candlewicking, Crewel, Reticello, Smocking, Swedish Embroidery, Trapunto)
12. Embroidery - Standard
13. Needlepoint
14. Miscellaneous Handiwork – including latch hook, yarn punch, felted item, etc.
