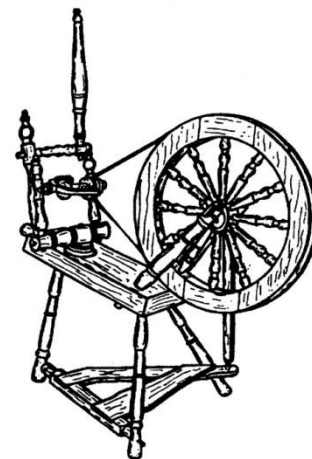


HOME SPUN YARN DIVISION

Rules

- A. For Spun Skeins, attach a tag with the following information to your entry:
 - Fiber Content (if known)
 - Intended End Use
 - Dye method (if used)
 - Indicate if Commercially Prepared or Not Commercially Prepared
 - Indicate Type of Yarn - fine, medium, bulky, novelty.
- B. For Completed Articles, attach a tag with the above information except Intended End Use.
- C. Each skein must be securely tied in at least 3 places. Minimum of 2 oz. skeins.
- E. Limit 5 entries per class, except only one entry in the Hand Spinners Yarn Basket class.
- F. The Gert Shockley Award will be given to the best homespun skein and the Tish Camp Award will be awarded to the best completed item.



CLASSES

1. Spun Skeins - single
2. Spun Skeins - plied
3. Spun Skeins - novelty
4. Completed Articles – Crocheted
5. Completed Articles – Knitted
6. Completed Articles – Other
7. Hand Spinners Yarn Basket - One lb. yarn displayed in basket. Include a description of fiber, technique and intended use. A pattern, sketch or sample swatch must be included.
