

HOME ECONOMICS CANNING

Rules

- A. Exhibit in Standard-Size Glass Jars.
- B. Each entry is two (2) jars of the same item.
- C. Label on bottom with method used.
- D. Canned items will be judged on the following criteria.

Produce

- Arrangement (practical use of space)
- Uniformity of sizes and shapes
- Condition
- Color (as natural as possible)

Liquid

- Clearness
- Proportion of Liquid to solid

Container

- Standard canning jars and jelly jars
- Neatness



- E. One jar will be opened. Lids must be complete with band or seal.
- F. Limit 10 entries per division, except for only one entry in the Pantry Shelf class.

CLASSES

- 1. Canned Vegetables
- 2. Canned Fruits
- 3. Jams and Jellies
- 4. Pickles
- 5. Relishes
- 6. Pantry Shelf - to be exhibited by each individual (one jar of each jam, jelly, preserve, relish, three different fruits and three different vegetables)
