Rules

- A. Driver must be at least 12 years old and a member of the South Jersey Gas Engine Club.
- B. There is not age limit on the tractor.
- C. STRICTLY STOCK TRACTORS ONLY!!!
- D. Draw bar height can be no higher than the center line of the rear axle. All drivers must provide a 2"-3" shackle suitable for quick and easy connection to the sled.
- E. Only OEM stock size rims are allowed. Maximum tire size is 23 x 10.50 x 12 except hi wheels. No cut tires, dual wheel, studded tires or tire chains.
- F. Engines must remain stock. 4000 rpm maximum on all engines. Engines must be of a garden tractor type with not more than 2 cylinders and a maximum rating of 22 hp.
- G. All tractors are required to have a hood.
- H. Operator must remain seated at all times.
- I. Front tires may not come more than 8" off the ground. Any higher and the tractor will be automatically disqualified from that round of eliminations.
- J. If ANYTHING falls off the tractor during the pull, the tractor will be automatically disqualified from that round of eliminations.
- K. Each garden tractor may pull only once within a weight class. Drivers may add or remove weight in order to pull in other weight classes.
- L. If an engine stalls before the sled is pulled 35', the operator will have the option of immediately re-pulling or accepting that pull. If the tractor has a mechanical failure before the sled is pulled 35' the operator may elect to pull again at the end of that class or accept that pull. If the driver elects to pull again last, that pull will be their official pull EVEN IF IT IS LESS THAN THEIR FIRST PULL.
- M. Drivers must start from tight chain. No jerk starting from a loose chain will be allowed.
- N. Drivers will take starting and stopping instructions from track officials only. Driver is required to stop at any time for breakdown or safety reasons.
- O. On site conditions can override some rules on any given day at the discretion of the track officials.
- P. The top competitors of every class MUST re-weigh.
- Q. The rules are subject to change. Any changes must be approved by club members. Additional classes may be added as deemed necessary.
- R. The flag man has the final word.
- S. ALL PARTICIPANTS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE FUN!! Don't let the competition ruin your day and don't ruin somebody else's day.
- T. \$5.00 hook-up fee.

12" Wheels.

1. 700 lb.
2. 850 lb.
3. 950 lb.
4. 1050 lb.
5. 1350 lb.
6. 1650 lb.

Any wheels over 12" pull in one class only.
