

HANDIWORK DIVISION

Rules

- A. Selection will be made on the basis of neatness of appearance, simplicity of pattern and usefulness of decoration.
- B. No sugar starch will be permitted.
- C. More than one piece in a set, fasten together and mount for display.
- D. Specify kit or original.
- E. Limit 5 entries per class.
- F. Either an Excellent, Very Good or Participation ribbon will be awarded to each entry. First, second, and third place ribbons will be awarded in each class. There is one Best of Show for each subdivision.



CLASSES

Subdivision A

1. Clothing
2. Fabric Work (such as braided rug, stuffed toy, pillow)
3. Woven Item

Subdivision B

4. Quilts – Combination Hand & Machine Stitched by entrant
5. Quilts – Hand pieced & Hand Quilted
6. Quilts – Hand or Machine pieced by entrant, commercially quilted

Subdivision C

7. Knitted Work- large
8. Knitted Work – small

9. Crocheted Work - large

10. Crocheted Work – small

11. Tatting

Subdivision D

12. Counted Cross Stitch

13. Embroidery - Miscellaneous (such as Bargello, Candlewicking, Crewel, Reticello, Smocking, Swedish Embroidery, Trapunto)

14. Embroidery - Standard

15. Needlepoint

16. Miscellaneous Handiwork – including latch hook, yarn punch, hand felted item, etc.
