General Dog Rules

- A. Dogs may enter only the class in which they are currently working.
- B. All entries must be up to date on distemper, parvo virus, and rabies vaccinations and may be asked for proof of vaccination.
- C. Any animal that shows signs of illness will be excused from the ring and sent home from the show grounds.
- D. Female dogs must be out of season five days.
- E. Dogs should be clean, well groomed, and wearing the correct collar and lead. Collars with prongs, electronic collars or collars that are either too tight or unreasonable large are not permitted in the show ring.
- F. Dogs must be on lead and under control at all times, or kept in a sturdy crate.
- G. Handlers are responsible for their dogs at all times, including clean-up.
- H. Handlers are required to supply fresh water for their dogs.
- I. Unnecessary severity in handling of dog can be cause for dismissal from the show by the judge.
- J. Any puppies who have not had their first shots against all the necessary diseases may not participate and for their own protection should not be brought to the show.
- K. This show is open to all participants, youth and adults.
- L. In accordance with NJ 4-H Program policy, participants of Prep age (having just completed grades 1-3) will receive participation ribbons and will not receive placings.

Awards

All animals will receive participation ribbons.

First through fourth place ribbons will be distributed in each class.

4-H members will be judged on the Danish system with participants receiving an Excellent, Very Good or Good rating.
