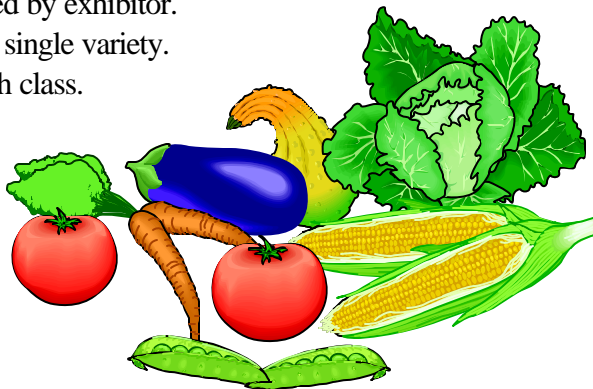


**AGRICULTURE**  
**OPEN CLASS VEGETABLES**

*Chairperson - Penns Grove F.F.A.*

**Rules**

- A. All entries must have been grown and selected by exhibitor.
- B. Each entry must consist of a correctly named single variety.
- C. Exhibitor may receive only one award in each class.
- D. Exhibitor will be furnished plates and identification tags.
- E. Exhibit must be in place no later than 8:30 p.m., Tuesday.
- F. Vegetables will be judged on quality.
- G. Ribbons will be awarded to 1st through 3rd place and Honorable Mention.
- H. If the number of specimens in an entry is not correct according to the class list, that entry will automatically receive an Honorable Mention.
- I. Entries may be picked up between 10:00 p.m.-11:00 p.m. on Friday. Entries not picked up on Friday will be discarded, however ribbons will be available at the Rutgers Cooperative Extension Office starting on Monday after the fair.
